















LEGO bricks can help develop and strengthen a family's ability to communicate with one another. Create two identical piles of LEGO bricks (sizes, colors, etc. must be the same in each pile). Family members pair up and either sit back-to-back or facing one another with a barrier (like a book or box) standing between them. One person then uses their pile of bricks to build something. Once the model is complete, they then must instruct the other person on how to build the same exact model without looking. Give verbal clues and instructions for which brick to place where. When finished, turn around or remove the barrier and see if the models match!
